The Lutheran World Federation is based in Geneva, Switzerland.

They will meet in Krakow, Poland on September 12-19, 2023. Its theme is "One Body, One Spirit, One Hope," with 355 official delegates from member churches around the world, ecumenical guests and volunteers.

The LWF is a global communion of churches of the Lutheran tradition, supporting people in need, promoting peace, human rights, gender justice, climate justice, women's empowerment and youth among 147 member churches in 99 countries.

The worldwide communion continues to grow. The German Evangelical Lutheran Church of Ukraine will be welcomed as the 149th, The Evangelical Lutheran Church of Georgia, (the country, not the state) has applied to be the 150th. Both were part of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Russia and other states (ELCROS) but have become independent as a result of the war on Ukraine.

Two other churches have applied for membership - - the Lutheran Church in Cambodia and the Geraia Niho Keriso Protestant Church in Indonesia. Both were the result of mission activity by the Lutheran Church in Singapore.

We don't often circulate news from this world-wide Lutheran community. But participation and awareness is how we grow past the attitude that only US things matter, that only our culture, our perspective matters. Through the LWF and a global perspective, our diversity - comes together into "One Body, One Spirit, One Hope."

"And hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Romans 5:5).



Sept 24. Rehearsals will continue Oct 15 and 19.


The choir welcomes people who've never played before but would like to try. It takes a group to make the choirs work
